**QUESTIONS**

*(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)*

1. [Ice-breaker] What are some ways that people answer the question “Who is Jesus”? Who would you answer it to someone who asked?
2. Why is Jesus’ identity so important? Can you be a Christian and not believe in Jesus as God?
3. How should we treat creation if we know it was made by the Creator? On the other hand, is it possible to elevate creation as being too important?
4. How do we sometimes act or speak as if light and darkness are equals? How does John correct this mistaken idea?
5. What roles did prophets fill in the Old Testament? How did they reveal God’s truth? How is John the Baptist’s ministry similar to or different from Old Testament prophets?
6. The best witnesses are selfless and Christ-exalting, Tony said. Why are these attributes important? And why do we struggle with them? How can we imitate John in these qualities?
7. What do we gain by having God as a Father? Why is this different than other religions or belief systems?
