QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Icebreaker: Tony mentioned the significance of memories surrounding food and bodies of water. What are some of your favorite memories including these? Why are both of these significant and memorable?
2. What was impactful to you about this sermon and text? What are some ways that you were challenged to respond?
3. As you think of Jesus as the greater Moses, how does this shape how we read and study both the Old and New Testaments? Were there any new thoughts/ideas you had as the similarities between Exodus and John 6 were explained.
4. Tony mentioned Philip and Andrew’s “hopeless solutions” to the problem. What they needed was a miracle, but they offered human, practical perspective to the problem. How can we do the same today? What causes us to take matters into our own hands and not believe Jesus?
5. Discuss the skeptics who attempt to disprove the miraculous and the supporting evidence that the miracles actually happened. Do you ever reflect this spirit of skepticism (and how)? How can we combat a spirit of skepticism in our hearts and engage others who might be skeptical?
6. How does this text affect our lives Monday-Saturday? Why does it matter? What changes if our actions match our beliefs about this text?
7. What does John 6 teach us about God's character as seen in Jesus?
