“They Cried, He Delivered”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1) Verses 4-32 contain four pictures of the Lord’s deliverance and rescue. When is a time that God delivered you from trouble?

2) Psalm 106 includes a prayer requesting God to deliver Israel from exile. Then, Psalm 107 includes a hymn of praise to God for answering the prayer of Psalm 106.

- a. Do you usually remember to praise God after He has answered your prayer?
- b. Does anyone have a strategy or practice that helps you remember to praise God after He has answered your prayer?
- c. Is there anything you need to publicly thank and praise God for now?

3) Pastor Tony responded to verse 2 by saying, “We who have been rescued should say something! We should never tire of speaking about our great God and Savior in praise and in evangelism.”

- a. What opportunities have you had this week to “say something” to an unbeliever about our great God?
- b. How can we pray for your evangelistic opportunities this week?

4) Verses 4-9 talk about God delivering “desolate wanderers”.

- a. How can we keep our hearts from wandering from God?
- b. When you have found your own heart wandering from God, what “good things” (v. 9) did God use to satisfy and deliver you?
