“Live Honorably”

QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. Peter calls his audience “beloved” and then exhorts them to good works. As a Christian, why does it matter that we get that order correct? (That being God’s beloved means we should do good works and not that good works makes us the beloved).
2. Pastor Tony pointed out that “good deeds” (v. 12) is the same word for beautiful. He said that beautiful deeds should mark “a lifestyle that attracts people to the beauty of the gospel”.
 - a. When is a time that you saw someone do something beautiful that attracted others to the gospel?
 - b. What are some ways that you can display this kind of beautiful lifestyle to those around you this week?
3. Verse 12 tells us that one goal of our good deeds should be to help bring others to know God and glorify Him.
 - a. What opportunities have you had to engage in gospel conversations with unbelievers over the past couple of weeks?
 - b. What upcoming opportunity will you have over the next week or so to engage in gospel conversation? Let us pray for these opportunities together.
4. Verse 17 calls us to “honor everyone” and verse 12 affirms that the world around us is watching our words and deeds.
 - a. In this cultural moment, why is it so important for Christians to act and speak well toward everyone?
 - b. How can Christians honor those who have experienced injustice while also “being subject to every human institution” (v. 13)?
