QUESTIONS

(potential discussion/conversation questions to use in your GGs this week)

1. In this passage, we see Jesus discipling his followers around various topics. We're all being disciplined. What are the primary discipling influences in your life? Where are some other competing sources of discipleship in our lives?
2. Why is it important for us to remember that temptation to sin is a normal part of following Jesus?
3. Have you ever been discouraged by your temptation?
4. What are some ways we can tempt others to sin (vv.1-2)?
5. How can we be a help to one another in temptation rather than the source of temptation?
6. What does it look like to lovingly rebuke one another (v.3)? How can we prepare our hearts to be ready to receive a rebuke?
7. Why is Jesus' teaching about forgiveness so challenging to us?
8. Can you tell of a time you've struggled to forgive? What was going on in your heart that kept you from obeying Jesus' teaching? What eventually led you to forgive?
9. How can small faith still be saving and powerful faith (vv.5-6)? What areas of your life demand faith—however small—in a great savior?
10. How is Jesus' parable about the unworthy servant (vv.7-10) challenging to us? What is Jesus warning us about as we follow him?
