## **QUESTIONS**

1. What does it mean "trust in ourselves that we are righteous" (v.9)? What does that look like in daily life? When do you come closest to doing this?
2. What does it mean to "treat others with contempt" (v.9)? When do you come closest to doing this?
3. The tax-collector seems to be very self-critical (v.13). How can he be appropriately self-critical without becoming unhealthily self-loathing?
4. The tax-collector correctly calls himself a "sinner." What are some ways we try to minimize sin in our own lives? How does this affect our relationship with the Lord?
5. Read James 4:6. How is it reflected in this passage? What's one way you can cultivate the humble heart of this Pharisee in the coming weeks?
6. In what ways do we need to become like a child to enter the kingdom of God (vv.15-17)? In what way(s) do you want to be more like a child as you follow Jesus?
